T What to Expect at Auditions

All dancers will check in at Studio D at our McCray Street Location.

- 1. Check-in & Number: Receive your audition number/badge. ==
- 3. Measurements: A staff member will take your dancer's measurements for costumes.
- 4. Photo for Casting: Quick headshot for casting purposes.
- 5. Merchandise Samples: Try on Nutcracker sweatshirt samples and fill out order forms (optional).
- 6. Audition Room: When the judges and choreographers are ready, dancers will be called in.
- 7. Dismissal: When the audition concludes, your dancer is excused. <a>

Helpful Tips

- Please arrive 15 minutes early to check in. 🖰
- Leveled ballet classes 1-7 and Beg/Interm Teen Ballet Wear ballet dress code attire. Don't forget your ballet shoes!
- Adult Dancers Wear comfortable clothing you can move in such as fitness attire. Bare feet or socks are appropriate if you do not have dance shoes.
- Gymnasts Ballet attire is appropriate or a gymnastics leotard.
